

- Please put out the garbage at the designated sites on collection days.
- Please use Manno Town-designated garbage bags (for a fee) when you dispose of burnable and non-burnable garbage. You can purchase them at supermarkets and convenience stores in Manno town.



Burnable Garbage

- ◆ Dispose of garbage by 8:00 a.m. on collection days.
- ◆ Capacity is up to 10 kg. Tie up the mouth of the bag crosswise with the handle.



Non-Burnable Garbage

- ◆ Dispose of garbage by 8:00 a.m. on collection days.
- ◆ Capacity is up to 10 kg. Tie up the mouth of the bag crosswise with the handle.



Used small household appliances

- ◆ Place in the collection box at the town hall.



Some used small household appliances can be disposed of as non-burnable garbage but their parts can be also recycled.



Recyclable Resources

- ◆ Sort recyclable resources into the appropriate categories and put them out at the designated sites on collection days.

Deleterious Garbage

- ◆ Sort and dispose of it at the designated sites on the day of collecting recyclable resources



Fluorescent tubes / LED
Put in the case you purchased and put out.



Batteries
Put them out in a transparent plastic bags.

Mercury thermometers
The main office, branch offices, sub-branch offices, and Karin Health Center's window collect them.



Oversized Garbage (Paid service)

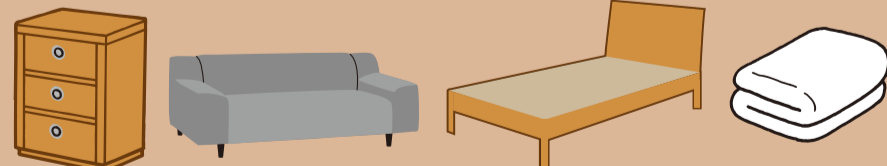
There is a fee for oversized garbage.

Please apply by e-mail to the Resident Life Division.

- Garbage collection days are designated. (Please confirm the garbage collection schedule.)
- Please let us know the applicant's address, name, telephone number, name of the community association, type and quantity of oversized garbage, and the length of the three sides (width, height, and depth) for furniture.
- Please write the receipt number on the oversized garbage sticker for the fee, put the sticker on the oversized garbage, and put it out in your yard, etc by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.
- Receipt number will be notified at the time of application.

Uncollectable garbage

Ask the dealer or specialist to dispose of the following items.

- Automobile parts
- Motorcycles
- LP gas cylinders
- Medical instruments
- Agricultural equipment, farming implements, and materials for agriculture (tractor claws, azenami, agricultural plastics, greenhouse plastics, sprayers, mowers, seedling boxes, etc.)
- Garbage generated from construction materials and contracted works, etc (roof tiles, tiles, bricks, concrete, blocks, plasterboards, iron pipes, bathtubs, screen doors, storm doors, aluminum sashes, IH cooking heaters, (built-in), boilers, solar water heaters, electric water heaters, etc.)
- Waste from stores, restaurants, offices, factories, etc.
- Other items that may interfere with collection or processing, etc.
- Tires
- Oil heaters (with oil)
- Paints, coatings, thinners, toxic substances
- Buddhist altars • Buddhist altar fittings • Shinto altars
- Powerful drugs • Deleterious chemicals Agricultural chemicals (including containers)
- Rocks, soil, sands
- Pianos
- Anything with liquid in it
- Equipment using refrigerant gas, such as dehumidifiers
- Waste oil (cars, machines, equipment, etc.)
- Unused fireworks and unused matches
- Batteries
- Fire extinguisher
